IMPLEMENTATION OF SOLID WASTE AND PUBLIC CLEANSING MANAGEMENT ACT 2007 (ACT 672) ON STRATIFIED PROPERTY EFFECTIVE 1ST JUNE 2016

As of 1st June 2016, every household in **Kuala Lumpur** is obliged to separate their solid waste in accordance with the Solid Waste and Public Cleansing Management Act 2007 (Act 672).

Failure to comply with the above will result in the Perbadanan Pengurusan Kiaramas Cendana being fined with RM100 (first offence), RM200 (second offence) and RM500 (third offence).

In line with the above, we would like to seek the cooperation of all residents to separate recyclable items and non-recyclable items into separate bags.

Below are the STEPS for recycling:

Step 1: Separate your waste

- (a) Residual waste: kitchen and food waste, soiled containers and dirty items
- (b) Recyclable items: separate items into four groups as shown, and place each group in a

separate bag

- (1) Plastic
- (2) Paper
- (3) Glass
- (4) Metal

Step 2:

Either take the recyclable items to the recycling bins located at the ground floor near the exit door at City Wing or leave them in the refuse room on your respective floor

Step 3:

Cleaners will collect recyclable items on a daily basis between 10:00 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Kindly separate your waste as indicated below:



PLASTIC

Examples: rigid plastic containers, drinking or soda bottles, straws, and other recyclable plastic-based items

PAPER

Examples: milk/juice cartons, paper bags, newspaper, cereal boxes, and other recyclable paper-based items



GLASS

Examples: jam jars, soda bottles, and other recyclable glass-based items



METAL

Examples: biscuit containers, canned food containers, and other recyclable metal-based items
